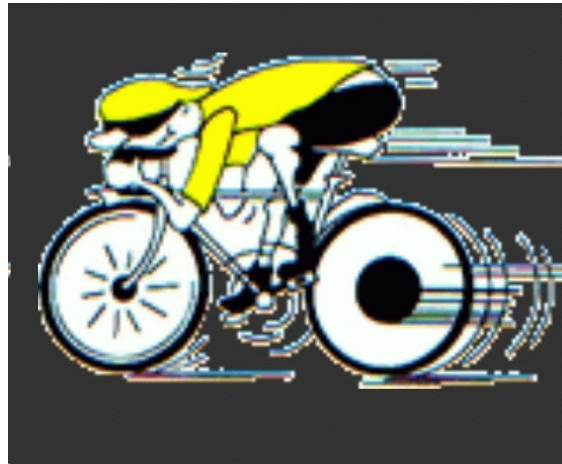

For the sole consideration of being permitted to participate in the Tour Autauga, I, intending to be legally bound, hereby release and forever discharge the Tour Autauga, and any sponsor, supporter, employee or entity affiliated with the Tour Autauga, Inc., along with any other volunteer, or owner/lessor of premises on which any part of, or any event associated with or related to the Tour Autauga takes place, and all other firms, persons, and corporations liable, or who might be claimed to be liable (each considered to be one of the "releasees" herein), from any and all claims, demands, damages, actions, causes of action, or suits of any kind and nature whatsoever, on account of any and all injuries both to my person and to my property, which may result from, or may in the future develop from, my participation in or travel to and from the Tour Autauga.

I understand that the Releasees are not responsible for, and are not insurers of, my personal safety during the Tour Autauga. I also understand that bicycling is an inherently dangerous activity and that the Tour Autauga is conducted on roads that will be open to the public and that other vehicles will be traveling on those roads during the Tour Autauga. I fully realize and appreciate the dangers of participating in an organized bicycle ride. I realize that the Tour Autauga requires physical conditioning and I represent that I am in proper physical condition to participate in this event. I fully assume any and all risks associated with my participation in the Tour Autauga, including, by way of example only and not in limitation, risks of effects of weather, (including extreme temperatures or conditions), traffic, contact with motor vehicles of all types and descriptions, collision with other riders, pedestrians or fixed or moving objects, and the conditions of the road. I agree to follow all applicable traffic laws and to wear an ANSI- or SNELL- approved helmet at all times while riding my bicycle.

I have completely read this release and I understand and accept the terms of it. I understand that the purpose of this release is to release all entities associated with the Tour Autauga from any and all claims on account of any injury I might sustain during the event and that by signing this release I have given up substantial rights.
